

ABOUT THE INTER-CLUB FUND

The Inter-Club Fund of San Francisco, Inc. was founded in 1972 and is a coalition of organizations from the greater Bay Area gay and lesbian community. It was formed to:

- Promote safe motorcycling through education
- Provide financial assistance to persons in distress
- Promote motorcycling organizations

The Fund is a non-profit 501(c)(3) charitable organization, has no paid staff and is funded exclusively through donations and fund-raising events conducted throughout the year.

MOTORCYCLE AWARDS

The annual ICF Motorcycle Awards dinner and ceremony is held every February and is one of the most anticipated Community events of the year. Recognition is given to clubs, organizations and individuals for community contributions and achievements during the past year. Many special categories exist recognizing motorcycle runs. The winners of individual awards are determined based upon votes cast by those who have actually participated in nominated events of the previous year.

Ticket sales to the Awards are available to the public.

The ICF Motorcycle Awards is the single most important fund-raising event conducted by the ICF during the year.



SAFE MOTORCYCLING

The ICF supports the efforts of its member clubs that promote safe motorcycling. Group rides in particular are more enjoyable and safer for everyone when riders are aware of and adhere to safe-riding procedures. The ICF has a history of promoting motorcycle safety education.

ICF MEMBER CLUBS

The member clubs of the ICF [listed on reverse] represent a wide variety of interests within the gay and lesbian community, not necessarily limited to leather and/or motorcycle organizations. Many of these clubs have been in existence for more than thirty years.

The social and fraternal activities of our member clubs are many, as are their contributions to the community through charitable fund-raising.

ABOUT ICF GRANTS

One of the purposes of the ICF as a non-profit organization is to provide grants to those in need due to illness, accident or other distress.

Grants are considered by the member representatives of the Clubs and Independent Directors that make up the Inter-Club Fund [the Board]. Anyone living in the San Francisco Bay Area who has actively supported the local gay and lesbian community and is in need of financial assistance is eligible to apply.

The Board reviews grant requests in a private, closed segment of its regular monthly session. Information provided to the Board by a prospective grantee is held in the strictest confidence. Approved grant funds are paid directly by the ICF to creditors [landlord, utilities, medical suppliers, etc.].
